You shall have no other gods before Me. Exodus 20:3

Other Gods (70x's)

Exodus 20:3 You shall have no other gods before Me.

Exodus 23:13 And in all that I have said to you, be circumspect and make no mention of the name of <u>other</u> gods, nor let it be heard from your mouth.

Deuteronomy 5:7 You shall have no other gods before Me.

Deuteronomy 6:14 You shall not go after other gods, the gods of the peoples who are all around you.

Deuteronomy 7:4 For they will turn your sons away from following Me, to serve other gods; so the anger of the LORD will be aroused against you and destroy you suddenly.

Deuteronomy 8:19 Then it shall be, if you by any means forget the LORD your God, and follow other gods, and serve them and worship them, I testify against you this day that you shall surely perish.

Deuteronomy 11:16 Take heed to yourselves, lest your heart be deceived, and you turn aside and serve <u>other</u> gods and worship them,

Deuteronomy 11:28 And the curse, if you do not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside from the way which I command you today, to go after other gods which you have not known.

Deuteronomy 13:2 And the sign or the wonder comes to pass, of which he spoke to you, saying, 'Let us go after other gods' —which you have not known—'and let us serve them.

Deuteronomy 13:6 If your brother, the son of your mother, your son or your daughter, the wife of your bosom, or your friend who is as your own soul, secretly entices you, saying, 'Let us go and serve other gods,' which you have not known, neither you nor your fathers.

Deuteronomy 13:7 Of the gods of the people which *are* all around you, near to you or far off from you, from *one* end of the earth to the *other* end of the earth.

Deuteronomy 13:13 Corrupt men have gone out from among you and enticed the inhabitants of their city, saying, "Let us go and serve other gods" —which you have not known—

Deuteronomy 17:3 Who has gone and served <u>other gods</u> and worshiped them, either the sun or moon or any of the host of heaven, which I have not commanded.

Deuteronomy 18:20 But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in My name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet shall die.

- Deuteronomy 28:14 So you shall not turn aside from any of the words which I command you this day, to the right or the left, to go after other gods to serve them.
- Deuteronomy 28:36 The LORD will bring you and the king whom you set over you to a nation which neither you nor your fathers have known, and there you shall serve other gods—wood and stone.
- Deuteronomy 28:64 Then the LORD will scatter you among all peoples, from one end of the earth to the <u>other</u>, and there you shall serve <u>other gods</u>, which neither you nor your fathers have known—wood and stone.
- Deuteronomy 29:26 For they went and served other gods and worshiped them, gods that they did not know and that He had not given to them.
- Deuteronomy 30:17 But if your heart turns away so that you do not hear, and are drawn away, and worship other gods and serve them.
- Deuteronomy 31:18 And I will surely hide My face in that day because of all the evil which they have done, in that they have turned to <u>other gods</u>.
- Deuteronomy 31:20 When I have brought them to the land flowing with milk and honey, of which I swore to their fathers, and they have eaten and filled themselves and grown fat, then they will turn to other gods and serve them; and they will provoke Me and break My covenant.
- Joshua 23:16 When you have transgressed the covenant of the LORD your God, which He commanded you, and have gone and served <u>other gods</u>, and bowed down to them, then the anger of the LORD will burn against you, and you shall perish quickly from the good land which He has given you.
- Joshua 24:2 And Joshua said to all the people, "Thus says the LORD God of Israel: 'Your fathers, *including* Terah, the father of Abraham and the father of Nahor, dwelt on the <u>other</u> side of the River in old times; and they served <u>other gods</u>.
- Joshua 24:14 Now therefore, fear the LORD, serve Him in sincerity and in truth, and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt. Serve the LORD!
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seems evil to you to serve the LORD, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that *were* on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- Joshua 24:16 So the people answered and said: "Far be it from us that we should forsake the LORD to serve other gods."
- Judges 2:12 And they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, who had brought them out of the land of Egypt; and they followed other gods from among the gods of the people who were all around them, and they bowed down to them; and they provoked the LORD to anger.
- Judges 2:17 Yet they would not listen to their judges, but they played the harlot with <u>other gods</u>, and bowed down to them. They turned quickly from the way in which their fathers walked, in obeying the commandments of the LORD; they did not do so.
- Judges 2:19 And it came to pass, when the judge was dead, that they reverted and behaved more corruptly than their fathers, by following other gods, to serve them and bow down to them. They did not cease from their own doings nor from their stubborn way.

- Judges 10:13 Yet you have forsaken Me and served other gods. Therefore I will deliver you no more.
- 1 Samuel 8:8 According to all the works which they have done since the day that I brought them up out of Egypt, even to this day—with which they have forsaken Me and served other gods—so they are doing to you also.
- 1 Samuel 26:19 Now therefore, please, let my lord the king hear the words of his servant: If the LORD has stirred you up against me, let Him accept an offering. But if *it is* the children of men, *may* they *be* cursed before the LORD, for they have driven me out this day from sharing in the inheritance of the LORD, saying, 'Go, serve other gods.'
- 1 Kings 9:6 *But* if you or your sons at all turn from following Me, and do not keep My commandments *and* My statutes which I have set before you, but go and serve <u>other gods</u> and worship them.
- 1 Kings 9:9 Then they will answer, 'Because they forsook the LORD their God, who brought their fathers out of the land of Egypt, and have embraced other gods, and worshiped them and served them; therefore the LORD has brought all this calamity on them.'
- 1 Kings 11:4 For it was so, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned his heart after <u>other gods</u>; and his heart was not loyal to the LORD his God, as *was* the heart of his father David.
- 1 Kings 11:10 And had commanded him concerning this thing, that he should not go after <u>other gods</u>; but he did not keep what the LORD had commanded.
- 1 Kings 14:9 But you have done more evil than all who were before you, for you have gone and made for yourself other gods and molded images to provoke Me to anger, and have cast Me behind your back—
- 2 Kings 5:17 So Naaman said, "Then, if not, please let your servant be given two mule–loads of earth; for your servant will no longer offer either burnt offering or sacrifice to other gods, but to the LORD."
- 2 Kings 17:7 For so it was that the children of Israel had sinned against the LORD their God, who had brought them up out of the land of Egypt, from under the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and they had feared other gods.
- 2 Kings 17:35 With whom the LORD had made a covenant and charged them, saying: "You shall not fear other gods, nor bow down to them nor serve them nor sacrifice to them."
- 2 Kings 17:37 "And the statutes, the ordinances, the law, and the commandment which He wrote for you, you shall be careful to observe forever; you shall not fear other gods.
- 2 Kings 17:38 And the covenant that I have made with you, you shall not forget, nor shall you fear other gods.
- 2 Kings 22:17 Because they have forsaken Me and burned incense to other gods, that they might provoke Me to anger with all the works of their hands. Therefore My wrath shall be aroused against this place and shall not be quenched.
- 2 Chronicles 7:19 But if you turn away and forsake My statutes and My commandments which I have set before you, and go and serve other gods, and worship them.

- 2 Chronicles 7:22 Then they will answer, Because they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, who brought them out of the land of Egypt, and embraced <u>other gods</u>, and worshiped them and served them; therefore He has brought all this calamity on them.
- 2 Chronicles 13:9 Have you not cast out the priests of the LORD, the sons of Aaron, and the Levites, and made for yourselves priests, like the peoples of <u>other</u> lands, so that whoever comes to consecrate himself with a young bull and seven rams may be a priest of things that are not gods?
- 2 Chronicles 28:25 And in every single city of Judah he made high places to burn incense to other gods, and provoked to anger the LORD God of his fathers.
- 2 Chronicles 32:13 Do you not know what I and my fathers have done to all the peoples of <u>other</u> lands? Were the <u>gods</u> of the nations of those lands in any way able to deliver their lands out of my hand?
- 2 Chronicles 32:17 He also wrote letters to revile the LORD God of Israel, and to speak against Him, saying, "As the gods of the nations of *other* lands have not delivered their people from my hand, so the God of Hezekiah will not deliver His people from my hand."
- 2 Chronicles 34:25 Because they have forsaken Me and burned incense to <u>other gods</u>, that they might provoke Me to anger with all the works of their hands. Therefore My wrath will be poured out on this place, and not be quenched.
- Jeremiah 1:16 I will utter My judgments Against them concerning all their wickedness, Because they have forsaken Me, Burned incense to other gods, And worshiped the works of their own hands.
- Jeremiah 7:6 If you do not oppress the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, and do not shed innocent blood in this place, or walk after other gods to your hurt.
- Jeremiah 7:9 Will you steal, murder, commit adultery, swear falsely, burn incense to Baal, and walk after <u>other</u> gods whom you do not know.
- Jeremiah 7:18 The children gather wood, the fathers kindle the fire, and the women knead dough, to make cakes for the queen of heaven; and *they* pour out drink offerings to <u>other gods</u>, that they may provoke Me to anger.
- Jeremiah 11:10 They have turned back to the iniquities of their forefathers who refused to hear My words, and they have gone after <u>other gods</u> to serve them; the house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken My covenant which I made with their fathers.
- Jeremiah 13:10 This evil people, who refuse to hear My words, who follow the dictates of their hearts, and walk after <u>other gods</u> to serve them and worship them, shall be just like this sash which is profitable for nothing.
- Jeremiah 16:11 Then you shall say to them, 'Because your fathers have forsaken Me,' says the LORD; 'they have walked after <u>other gods</u> and have served them and worshiped them, and have forsaken Me and not kept My law.
- Jeremiah 16:13 Therefore I will cast you out of this land into a land that you do not know, neither you nor your fathers; and there you shall serve other gods day and night, where I will not show you favor.

- Jeremiah 19:4 Because they have forsaken Me and made this an alien place, because they have burned incense in it to other gods whom neither they, their fathers, nor the kings of Judah have known, and have filled this place with the blood of the innocents.
- Jeremiah 19:13 And the houses of Jerusalem and the houses of the kings of Judah shall be defiled like the place of Tophet, because of all the houses on whose roofs they have burned incense to all the host of heaven, and poured out drink offerings to other gods.
- Jeremiah 22:9 Then they will answer, 'Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD their God, and worshiped other gods and served them.
- Jeremiah 25:6 Do not go after other gods to serve them and worship them, and do not provoke Me to anger with the works of your hands; and I will not harm you.
- Jeremiah 32:29 And the Chaldeans who fight against this city shall come and set fire to this city and burn it, with the houses on whose roofs they have offered incense to Baal and poured out drink offerings to other gods, to provoke Me to anger.
- Jeremiah 35:15 I have also sent to you all My servants the prophets, rising up early and sending *them*, saying, "Turn now everyone from his evil way, amend your doings, and do not go after <u>other gods</u> to serve them; then you will dwell in the land which I have given you and your fathers.' But you have not inclined your ear, nor obeyed Me.
- Jeremiah 44:3 Because of their wickedness which they have committed to provoke Me to anger, in that they went to burn incense *and* to serve <u>other gods</u> whom they did not know, they nor you nor your fathers.
- Jeremiah 44:5 But they did not listen or incline their ear to turn from their wickedness, to burn no incense to other gods.
- Jeremiah 44:8 In that you provoke Me to wrath with the works of your hands, burning incense to other gods in the land of Egypt where you have gone to dwell, that you may cut yourselves off and be a curse and a reproach among all the nations of the earth?
- Jeremiah 44:15 Then all the men who knew that their wives had burned incense to other gods, with all the women who stood by, a great multitude, and all the people who dwelt in the land of Egypt, in Pathros, answered Jeremiah, saying.
- Daniel 2:11 *It is* a difficult thing that the king requests, and there is no <u>other</u> who can tell it to the king except the gods, whose dwelling is not with flesh.
- Hosea 3:1 Then the LORD said to me, "Go again, love a woman who is loved by a lover and is committing adultery, just like the love of the LORD for the children of Israel, who look to other gods and love the raisin cakes of the pagans."

Foreign Gods (12x's)

- Genesis 35:2 And Jacob said to his household and to all who were with him, "Put away the <u>foreign gods</u> that are among you, purify yourselves, and change your garments.
- Genesis 35:4 So they gave Jacob all the <u>foreign gods</u> which *were* in their hands, and the earrings which *were* in their ears; and Jacob hid them under the terebinth tree which *was* by Shechem.

- Deuteronomy 32:16 They provoked Him to jealousy with <u>foreign gods</u>; With abominations they provoked Him to anger.
- Joshua 24:20 If you forsake the LORD and serve <u>foreign gods</u>, then He will turn and do you harm and consume you, after He has done you good.
- Joshua 24:23 "Now therefore," *he said*, "put away the <u>foreign gods</u> which *are* among you, and incline your heart to the LORD God of Israel."
- Judges 10:16 So they put away the <u>foreign gods</u> from among them and served the LORD. And His soul could no longer endure the misery of Israel.
- 1 Samuel 7:3 Then Samuel spoke to all the house of Israel, saying, "If you return to the LORD with all your hearts, *then* put away the <u>foreign gods</u> and the Ashtoreths from among you, and prepare your hearts for the LORD, and serve Him only; and He will deliver you from the hand of the Philistines."
- 1 Kings 11:8 And he did likewise for all his foreign wives, who burned incense and sacrificed to their gods.
- 2 Chronicles 14:3 for he removed the altars of the <u>foreign gods</u> and the high places, and broke down the *sacred* pillars and cut down the wooden images.
- 2 Chronicles 33:15 He took away the <u>foreign gods</u> and the idol from the house of the LORD, and all the altars that he had built in the mount of the house of the LORD and in Jerusalem; and he cast *them* out of the city.
- Jeremiah 5:19 And it will be when you say, 'Why does the LORD our God do all these *things* to us?' then you shall answer them, 'Just as you have forsaken Me and served <u>foreign gods</u> in your land, so you shall serve aliens in a land *that is* not yours.'
- Acts 17:18 Then certain Epicurean and Stoic philosophers encountered him. And some said, "What does this babbler want to say?" Others said, "He seems to be a proclaimer of <u>foreign gods</u>," because he preached to them Jesus and the resurrection."
